Video script:

[Welcome to the GLOBAL EDUCATION GOES POP course! We, the team of the “Global Education goes local” project, are super excited to have you on board and would like to wish you an amazing learning journey.

The general idea of this MOOC is to bring the global education dimension into youth work by exploring and learning how to use the POP culture as an element of mobilizing young people and connecting them to the Sustainable development goals.

You may ask yourself: Why global education? Why pop culture?

Today we live in an interdependent and changing world, filled with challenges and opportunities. To assist young people in understanding and tackling these global challenges, we need to provide opportunities for the youth to learn about and explore global issues.

Global Education does not provide the answers to all the questions of our time, but it does offer the potential to support young people in becoming conscious global citizens who question the world and are committed to their ideals.

Young people today consider popular culture to be ‘cool’. We define the pop culture as a relationship associated with young people’s everyday interests of music, art, media, internet, TV, radio and fashion – it offers creativity, challenges, participation and engagement.

When you see a Lady Gaga music video, do you think of it as a teachable material? Probably not. But pop culture is a useful tool that can help get youth interested and engaged in learning, and even offer resources for better understanding global issues.

This course is a result of a 2-year working experience of organisations from 6 European countries that collaborated together within a project called GLOBAL EDUCATION GOES LOCAL, co-financed by the EUROPEAN UNION's program Europe Aid. We will show you a variety of approaches and tools that we developed while practicing global education with a great number of local communities with the aim of activating young people to become active global citizens.

The course is composed of 4 modules, which will take you around 3 to 4 hours per week to complete.

The module 0 is about kicking off the process and getting an overview of what the course is about, its structure, content, the way it's facilitated and the way the platform works. On the other hand, it will provide space to introduce yourselves to the rest of the learners and start sharing expectations, experience and building up this community of learners.

In the module 1 we will explore the topic of global interconnectedness and interdependence and the concepts of global education /global learning/ global citizenship education, as well as its connection to the Sustainable Development Goals. Moreover, through different exercises, we will reflect on how those issues are connected to local and personal realities and what the role of young people as active citizens is in meeting the SDG targets.

The module 2 will focus on understanding better the phenomena of POP culture: its role in young people's lives and its influence on young people as global citizens. We will reflect on the link between pop culture and global education and global issues and finally learn about how to use POP culture in Non-formal education to better engage young people in our educational activities.

The module 3 focuses on education: so how to work with Young people using POP culture? We will offer some concrete tools you can use in different educational contexts to motivate Young people to become active global citizens through expressing their thoughts and ideas in the creative way. We will take a look into the competences that need to be developed or improved in order to use pop culture in this work, and finally, you will be invited to share your own ideas and ways of dealing with the subject and receive feed-back from the rest of the learners.

The final aim of global education is to achieve a positive change of behaviors and empowerment to take action, and this is what the MODULE 4 will try to explore: First we will understand what action means in the context of global education. We will take a look into different types of action and good practices from our GEGL project. Finally, we will share some tips on how to prepare for action and mobilize young people in activating themselves.

So, we hope that the course will meet your expectations, that will adapt to what you need in order to work these issues with young people. We hope to see you around, to get the chance to interact through different tasks and the forum and learn as well about your ideas and experience you have with the topic.]

(TEXT) Course Structure

This is an instructor lead course and you will need approximately 3 hours per course module to complete it. Each module has a space for interaction with the rest of the learning community and it depends on you on how much you want to use it. We strongly encourage you to join in. Contributing in discussions and sharing questions and thoughts with the rest will make this learning journey more incredible.

MODULE 1

- Understand the concepts of global education /global learning/ global citizenship education and its relation to SDGs
- Understand the role of young people as active citizens in meeting the SDG targets

MODULE 2

- To understand the phenomena of POP culture and its role in the life of young people, how POP culture is influencing young people as global citizens
- To reflect how we can use POP culture in Non-formal education to better engage young people, making it easy, fun and close to young people
- To reflect on the needs and interests of young people and get to know better the target group whom we work with and their pop culture.
- To start exploring the link between pop culture and global education and global issues.
